

VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS



VOLUNTEER WISH GRANTING:



Our wish granting volunteers are instrumental in helping us get to the heart of a wish for a wish child. They work with a Wish Specialist, Make-A-Wish staff member, and meet with wish families at centralized locations to determine the child's one true wish. They also provide wish enhancements once the wish has been scheduled to build on the excitement of a wish come true!

WISH GRANTER REQUIREMENTS

- Daytime/weekday availability
- Complete and submit application of interest
- Complete a self-paid background check
- Complete annual Conflict of Interest Form (*due every January*)
- Attend 3 hour wish granter training
- Purchase Make-A-Wish t-shirt to wear at your Wish Discovery Visits (*\$5 per shirt*)
- Plan and deliver one enhancement piece/party per wish
- Sign up for a minimum of 8 wishes per year
